Despite Housing Woes, Liberty Hill builds affordable homes!

Inkster, MI. – October 3, 2008 –There is good news happening in the city of Inkster when it comes to affordable and accessible housing! Liberty Hill Housing Corporation, in partnership with the city, just opened the doors to its 2nd home in the community. The home, located at 30132 Oakwood, is three bedrooms, wheelchair accessible and ready for someone to move in!

“We are pleased to continue our partnership and are looking forward to building more homes in the city,” said Executive Director Peggy Frankie. “Liberty Hill is dedicated to Inkster residents and wants people to know there are affordable housing options for people with disabilities in their communities.”

This new home was funded with a capital advance grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. Each person’s portion of rent will be no more than 30% of their income, with rental assistance from HUD for the remainder.

Inkster Mayor Hillard Hampton Jr. was on hand to cut the ribbon of this brand new home and is pleased with Liberty Hill’s efforts to invest in the city.

Liberty Hill Treasurer and Inkster resident Curtisene Barge is happy to offer accessible housing to people with disabilities. “It’s the American Dream to have a home of your own and now people with disabilities have choices and options just like the rest of us.” Several people supported by Community Living Services, Inc., an affiliate to Liberty Hill, expressed interest in moving in soon, including Board member Jerry Zink. “These homes are so nice and I can’t wait to move into one myself,”
